

Post-Doctoral Position Open in The Center for Adaptation Genetics and Drug Resistance

A post-doctoral fellowship position is available in the laboratory of Dr. Stuart Levy, The Center for Adaptation Genetics, Department of Molecular Biology and Microbiology, Tufts University School of Medicine, Boston, MA. The topic of research is the mechanism of antibiotic resistance in UPEC strains.

Highly motivated candidates should have:

- A PhD degree in Molecular Biology, Biochemistry and/or Microbiology, and no more than 3 years of postdoctoral experience.
- Extensive expertise with hands-on skills in molecular biology (restriction enzyme cloning, site-directed mutagenesis, mutagenesis by homologous recombination, PCR including primer design, RT-qPCR, DNA/RNA isolation), western blotting, cell culture (BSL2), and ideally *in vivo* studies in mice.
- Computer skills including Word, Excel, Powerpoint, etc.
- Excellent verbal and written English.
