For those interested, please send an **email of intent** to the Limited Submissions Team at limitedsubmissions@tufts.edu informing us of an intention to apply. EOI's received after the deadline will not be considered. The email of intent must include:

1. *The name of the solicitation,*
2. *The name of the Principal Investigator, and any co-PI's,*
3. *A 2-3 sentence description of the proposed project.*

Should the number of interested applicants exceed the number allowed by the funder, an internal selection process will be conducted by the Office of the Vice Provost for Research, and candidates will be notified to submit internal application materials. All candidates will be notified of results. NB: Successful applications must include official notification from the Limited Submissions Team in order to submit. PROGRAM PURPOSE:

- To support children and youth who are crime victims as a result of the opioid crisis by addressing the existing gap in victims' services and developing new programs or support structures for existing service providers.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- **Purpose Area 1: Direct Services**
 - 1) Deliver information, services, and support to children and youth who are crime victims as a result of the opioid crisis;
 - 2) Build and implement a feedback system to further identify and define the scope of the community- or jurisdiction-specific problem, the associated victim needs, the resources and services available, and remaining gaps to be addressed.
 - 3) Establish or enhance a seamless, comprehensive, community driven, and multidisciplinary response to children and youth who are crime victims as a result of the opioid crisis.
- **Purpose Area 2: Support Services: Must have a wide array of expertise and partnerships; national scope**
 - 1) Actively provide tools and support to the direct services program sites to enhance their delivery of information, services, and support
 - 2) Support direct services program sites to establish and apply appropriate feedback systems to further identify and define the scope of the problem, the associated victim needs, the available resources, and the remaining gaps to be addressed
 - 3) Where possible, support a comprehensive, community-driven, multidisciplinary response to children and youth who are crime victims as a result of the opioid crisis.

ELIGIBILITY INFORMATION: No agency restrictions; please follow [Tufts PI Eligibility Policies](#)

AWARD INFORMATION:

- **Purpose Area 1:** Up to 32 awards for a period of 3 years ranging from \$300,000 to \$750,000
- **Purpose Area 2:** A single award of up to \$2.5 million for a period of 3 years
