Dr. Bruce Boghosian is a Professor of Mathematics, and an Adjunct Professor of Computer Science and Physics at Tufts University. Dr. Boghosian received his PhD from the University of California, Davis. Dr. Boghosian's research focuses on theoretical and computational fluid dynamics, with emphasis on an improved understanding of fluid turbulence.

Dr. Boghosian's research group is developing a database of available data on world wealth distribution, and its analysis using novel mathematical and statistical models; the database will focus on wealth rather than income. In addition to contributions to the field, Dr. Boghosian's work also raises interesting questions in economics and ethics, and he has collaborated with faculty in the Departments of Economics and Philosophy, among others.
