Dr. Eli Upfal is a computer science researcher and currently the Rush C. Hawkins Professors of Computer Science at Brown University. Dr. Upfal received his PhD from Hebrew University. Dr. Upfal's general research area is theory of computation: trying to apply rigorous mathematical tools to the design and analysis of computer algorithms.

Dr. Upfal is a fellow of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers and a fellow of the Association for Computing Machinery. Recent work includes: Developing probabilistic techniques for studying the long-term behavior of dynamic computer processes such as communication, load balancing, caching, and paging; a novel combinatorial design improving the design of sequencing by hybridization (SBH) microchips; and stochastic analysis of commodity trading strategies.
